

Germany wins Mr Gay World 2015

GERMANY'S Klaus Burkart has defeated 20 other entrants from around the world to win the 2015 sash for Mr Gay World.

The 21-year-old milk technician, in his application to be a part of the pageant contest, said he wanted to win Mr Gay World to "be a role model for young gays all over the world and help them with their coming out and also change young people's opinion of homosexuality".

While not winning the competition this year, Australian entrant Scott Fletcher received the Special Award for the swimwear category.

This year's competition seemed to go off without complication, unlike the 2014 competition in Rome that saw Australian entrant Chris Glebatsas and New Zealand entrant Troy Williams suddenly leave halfway through due to what they thought was a lack of professionalism from the contest organisers.
